COURSES OFFERED:

PHARMACY:

Course: Diploma in Pharmacy (D. Pharm.)
Duration: 02 Years
Eligibility: Intermediate (10+2) pass with Science stream (Biology/ Maths)
Course Scope: D. Pharma makes person eligible to work as registered Pharmacist in India. After completing the course person can get employment opportunities as Pharmacist in private and government hospitals. Person can work in health clinics, NGOs, community health centers. The course also enable person to get entry level job in pharmaceutical companies at various divisions like Process Control, Manufacturing and Quality Control. Person can work as Medial Representative. Although, there is pressure of meeting target in this profession, but incentives and other perks makes this profession quite rewarding.

PARAMEDICAL:

Course: Diploma in Medical Laboratory Technology (DMLT)
Duration: 02 Years
Eligibility: Intermediate (10+2) pass with Science stream (Biology/ Maths)
Course Scope: Medical Laboratory technologists examine and analyze body fluids, tissues, blood typing, micro organisms, screening, chemical analyses, cell counts etc. of the human body. They play an important role in collecting the information needed for treating most pathology cases by sampling, testing, analyzing and reporting such investigations.

Course: Diploma in Operation Theatre Assistant (DOTA)
Duration: 02 Years
Eligibility: Intermediate (10+2) pass with Science stream (Biology/ Maths)
Course Scope: Operation Theater Assistants find employment in hospitals, surgical centers, and healthcare facilities. With experience, they can advance to supervisory roles, specialize in specific surgical disciplines, or pursue further education to become Surgical Technologists. Sterilizing/ Cleaning all instruments in the OT and maintaining utmost hygiene in the OT. Assisting the Doctor/ Surgeon in all equipment required for Surgery before, during and after the Surgery.

Course: Certificate in Dresser (C.D.)
Duration: 01 Year
Eligibility: Matric (10 th) pass/ Intermediate (10+2) pass with any stream (Science/ Arts/ Commerce)
Course Scope: Dressers are the first medical-Aid provider as doing very good private and independent practice without having very big infrastructural investment. Along with the above self employment option dressers are in great requisition in every medical organization, private medical clinic, nursing home and hospital.

NURSING:

Course: Auxiliary Nurse & Midwifery (ANM)
Duration: 02 Years
Eligibility: Intermediate (10+2) pass with any stream (Science/ Arts/ Commerce)
Course Scope: ANM graduates easily get employed in the government as well as the private sectors. These ANM professionals mostly work in government and private hospitals, nursing homes, assisted living facilities, orphanages, various businesses, sanatoriums, and the military.

Admission Criteria

1. The minimum age for admission shall be 15 years on or before 31st March of the year in which admission is sought.
2. There is no upper age limit for the applicants.
3. The minimum educational requirements shall be the passing of 10 years of schooling for Certificate Course and 12 years of schooling (10+2 year) for Diploma Courses recognized by CBSE/ICSE/SSSCE/HSCE or a recognized equivalent examination.
4. Admission is subjected to satisfactory medical examination report.

Scholarship

Scholarship facility is available for SC, ST and OBC candidates. Colleges are registered with the Welfare Department, Govt. of Jharkhand as a higher education Institution and information is available in the e- kalyan portal. As per provision each SC, ST and OBC candidates of Jharkhand is entitled to scholarships.

Medium of Instruction

The medium of instruction shall be English and Hindi.

Uniform

It is mandatory to wear the uniform from day one of your life at the college campus.

LIBRARY

Library is one of the important activities as far as education is concerned and Ambedkar College values these sentiments. As library is a part and parcel of every institute. It is our college endeavor to provide best library maintains an in-depth collection of around 1100 professional, 1000 textbooks on all the specialties on Pharmacy, Nursing and Paramedical science, plus an extended collection of various journals from India and abroad, integrated resource packages, sound recording, e- learning modules, microfiche and video tapes. Study tables, preview facilities and photocopies are available. Brief reference help is offered at most times.

The Library is available for student use during the following time frames:

10:00 AM to 02:00 PM (Monday to Friday)

HOSTEL

The Institution has a hostel. In this hostel, the facilities for Fooding and Lodging, Supply of Water, recreation room, visitor's room, securities and telephone facilities have been provided round the clock.

Hostel facility is available to female candidates in the campus and to the male candidates, outside of the campus.

In consideration of the distance and urgency of hostel applicants, College authorities will allow selected students to get admission in the hostel. This is due to limited seats in the hostel.

GUIDELINES FOR INTERNSHIP:

1. The students should be posted in the Sadar hospital/ Primary health centre/ Community health centre / Private Hospitals with a regular candidate for 1- 6 months for supervised independent practice in the Hospitals.
2. The students should be participating in all National Health and Family welfare program during their clinical experience.
3. At least 80% of all the Academic and Clinical requirements should be completed before appearing for the final examination.
4. The CEO/Principal of the College certify for each student that he/she has undergone successfully the internship program, completed 100% of the clinical requirements and acquired the requisite competencies as listed in the syllabus before the award of the certificate/ diploma by the Council/ examination board.
5. The Practical or competency record book should be completed and signed by the competent authority of the college before appearing for the final examination.

Attendance

A good record will enhance academic performance. The students who are absent for personally illness or compassionate reason will be excused when the reason is communicated by parents/ guardians in legally written writing.

Absence for the students should be communicated to the Principal/ Academic Office by 10:00 AM on the day of the absence in question. Absence for reason such as "vacation" time will receive no special consideration. Class work for which one is absent for reasons such as "suspension" from Institution or any other "unexcused absence" will be graded as zero and they have to be paying fine of Rs. 50 per day.

Frequent absenteeism will necessitate conferences with both students and parents in an attempt to improve one's academic performance. If a student fails to complete 80% attendance in the session, the feasibility of appearing in the examination is forfeited. Parents will be informed of any such situations. Permission to appear in examination, however, may be earned in situation when a Doctor's Certificate is presented to the college, and provided arrangements have been made with the Principal to complete work. An inordinate number of absences will result in suspension from college activities.

Students who are absent from the Institution (for reasons other than Institution related activities) are not eligible to participate in any extra- curricular activity which would take them out of class(es) until they have had opportunity to attend and make up the lost time and course work for the class(es) for which they were absent.

Students coming late in the class will be marked absent for the lecture.

Discipline

All the students will have to abide strictly by the rules and regulations of the Institution and hostel during their studies enforced from time to time. Any violation will be strictly dealt with. The CEO/ Principal reserve the right to rusticate students found indulging in acts prejudicial to the interest of the institute or involved in gross indiscipline or immoral act.

Council Examination

Students shall be required to attend a regular course of study. Candidates should have attended at least 80% of the total number of lectures delivered and practical done in each subject and 80% attendance in Clinical experience is needed during each academic year. The procedure of examination will be in the form of terminals, semester, pre- council followed by the Council examination in every one and two year.

Admission Form

Prospectus and Admission Form can be obtained in the Admin Office on all working days on payment of the prescribed fee by Cash/ Cheque/ Online/ Net Banking of any nationalized bank. The Form can also be downloaded from our website and dully filled in all respect shall be submitted to the Admission Department of the College along with the required documents through the by hand/ by post along with Cheque/ DD of Rs. 500/- (Five Hundred) only.

Admission Fee

The institution shall charge only such fee as prescribed by the affiliating body/ Govt. of Jharkhand in accordance with provisions of the Councils. The fees can be deposited in the cash counter of college by Cash/ Cheque/ Online/ Net Banking of any nationalized bank. The fee will be collected on a monthly/ quarterly basis at the beginning of each term of monthly/ quarterly, to avoid penalty (fine). However, fees must be cleared before 30 days of filling up the examination form semester wise.

Returned or dishonored Cheque/ DD of any amount given by the candidate during admission will automatically cancel his/ her admission. Cancellation of admission for any reason will entail deduction of Rs. 5,000/- (Five Thousand) from admission fees deposited by the candidate within 02 days of the admission. Under no circumstances will refund of admission and other fees be made, if cancellation is made after 24 hours of admission.

The candidate whose admission has been cancelled from any reason, they may be re- admitted with the re- admission fee which is equivalent to admission fee. The maximum time for re- admission is 30 days only.

Verification of Documents

An incomplete application form will be automatically rejected. Original documents will be verified by the Admission committee. Non- availability of any original certificate or mark sheet or CLC/ SLC/DLC on the date of admission will lead to debarment from admission. Student may submit a declaration to produce her/ his Migration Certificate within 30 days from the date of her/his admission.

Intimation of Selection

College will intimate to the candidates only those who are selected through e-mail and over phone. No candidate will be informed about her/his rejection of application form unless and until there is any request from candidate side. It is implied that if the name of candidate is neither in selection nor in waiting list, then she/he is discard from admission. The merit list will be available in college notice board and also in the website. College will provide 10 days of time to the selected candidates to take admission; failing to it will automatically cancel the merit rank of the concerned students.

Ragging

Ragging is strictly prohibited in the Institution campus as well as in the hostel. Students are required to maintain cordial relationship with everyone and a discipline atmosphere in the College Campus.

Clinical Training

The students are requiring being in the clinical area for eight hours every day during the week, according to the course planning. Selected field trips will be arranged to different community agencies as per course plan. The Clinical Practice is given at well equipped hospitals with all advanced facilities and specialties covering all departments.

Sports

Sports facility is an integral part of any educational activity to keep students healthy both physically and mentally. Looking at these aspects college has established huge sports complex consisting of indoor and outdoor game facilities. Meditation, hobby centre, recreation room, health care centre and other such parts of the college grooms the physical and mental development of the students essential for learning and assimilation.

Social Service

Once a week students will be involved in social work for two hours according to the instructions of the CEO/ Principal.

Jurisdiction

In case of any dispute, decision of the Principal is final and territorial jurisdiction for suing shall be limited to Ranchi only.

Medicare

Monitoring of health of the students is done on routine basis. Regular check-ups are done to ensure fitness of the students. Nourishing and balanced diet is provided in the hostel. In case of illness, special Medicare is available through medical experts. The Institution is also accomplished with well equipped sick room with services available round the clock. In case of external medical assistance, the student will be accompanied to the hospital.

Mess

Institution has its own spacious mess to provide nutritious and vegetarian or non- vegetarian food to the students. The management of the college directly controls the mess activities. Breakfast, Lunch, Evening tea and dinner are served at respective timings.

Placement Cell

“DBRAGC” organizational personal relationship department and development cell will assist students for exploring possibilities of employment in accordance with their competence and capability for the pass out students of the college.

Parking Place

Cycle, Motor-bikes and motor cars are allowed inside the campus on production of the Identity card by the students at the main gate. The students must be in uniform. Abandonment of vehicles at the parking lot by the students will be considered a breach of discipline.

Visitors

No guardian/relatives will be allowed inside the campus unless she/ he have any genuine reason/work in the college office.
